AMD World Championship of Custom Bike Building

- Bike must be presented at AMD Marquee between 7am and 8am on Sat 30th August 2008.
- No AMD Show entry fee applies BUT normal Bike Week entry fee is payable.
- Bikes can only be entered by the BUILDER (or his authorised representative).
- AMD Show is only open to bikes built in Australia and New Zealand.
- All entries will be judged in one FREESTYLE category. (One-off ground up Custom. Any design or modification is accepted.)
- Judging panel to be led by Robin Bradley-owner/publisher of AMD magazine.
- Builders may get a vote if entry numbers are sufficient.
- Trikes may be entered.
- Displays ARE allowed but no more than ONE meter around your bike. (Not allowed in Sturgis).
- Bikes MUST start and be ridden to display area.
- Bikes MAY be “cross entered” into the Saturday Custom Bike and Chopper Show.
- No entries will be accepted after August 18, 2008.
- Entrants MUST complete and return the official Entry Form.
- ONE BIKE PER ENTRY FORM.
- A brief technical specification MUST be submitted by August 18 to assist you and the judges to understand your bike.
- Entrants will be issued an official Entry Number which must be brought to the Show.
- All entrants will receive a Certificate of Participation.
- No bikes may be removed before the Awards Ceremony at 3pm on Sat August 30.
- Winning Builder and Bike will be invited to compete in the AMD World Championship of Custom Bike Building FINALS in Sturgis 2009. Prize value up to \$10,000.
- Timetable:
 - Entry forms in ASAP but no later than Mon August 18.
 - Tech specification in ASAP but no later than Mon August 18.
 - Bikes to AMD marquee 7-8am Sat August 30.
 - Judging 9am-11am Sat August 30.
 - Awards Ceremony 3pm Sat August 30.
 - Bikes may be removed after Awards Ceremony.
